ightarrow GAME INFORMATION

ROSTERS: As we draw closer to the game, we will work on dividing up the skaters to help create the most balanced and fair game we can. We are asking everyone who has never played in one of our Black vs. Yellow games to please visit our Black vs. Yellow game website page at https://www.wmphantoms.com/bvsgquestions and complete your 'New Player Sign-Up Questions'. This helps us get an idea for your skill level and helps us work to create balanced teams. As with many of these games, we are are excited to see new players join us for an afternoon of fun, but it does create some work to ensure fun and competitive rosters are created. Your



help to honestly and accurately complete the questions will greatly help us in that quest. Once our new players have completed the questions, we will begin to assemble teams behind the scenes. During the day of the game, we will have two captains that will work with Kevin Wootton (organizer and goalie) to help ensure a smooth game. Slight adjustments may be needed during the game in the event the game gets too lop-sided. We would like to remind everyone that this game is just a scrimmage game and that the event is played to give everyone a new experience at a new rink and to build friendships and play hockey at the same time. We are men's league players of various skill levels, not NHL'ers.

JERSEYS/SOCKS: We will provide jerseys and socks for the players during this game, HOWEVER, will request them back after the game. These jerseys and socks are used in our men's leagues back in West Michigan and therefore we need them back. For the Toledo game, we are planning on using the Black and Yellow jerseys. In terms of socks, the Black socks will be used for the Black team, while the yellow (and gray) socks will be used for the yellow team.

SKATE TIME: We will have the ice from 3:30pm to 5:00pm. We request players/fans to show up around 2:30pm to begin entry into the rink.

GAME FORMAT: We will have a warm-up of 5 minutes and then run three periods of 14 minutes each---third period length may be adjusted based on how much time we have left. There will be NO Zamboni between periods. We will use the last 5-10 minutes of our time slot for group photos and individual photos. C2 Visual Media LLC will be joining us to take photographs of the game. These photos are normally available a few days after the event.

REFEREES: We are working to secure one additional referee for this scrimmage. Walt Clarke from Walker Ice & Fitness will be joining us as one of the referees for the game. While these scrimmage games are fun and we don't expect many penalties, the referees help speed up the flow of the game and allow them to also experience these special games. If you know of any referee that may be interested, please have them reach out to Kevin Wootton.

BEER/LIQUOR/DRUGS/WEAPONS NO outside food/beer/liquor will be allowed into the arena for our game or for the Walleye game. Additionally, no drugs or weapons are allowed into the Huntington Center. Please visit the arena's website at https://huntingtoncentertoledo.com for additional information.

LOCKER ROOMS Everyone will be asked to leave the locker rooms and arena by 5:30pm. This doesn't give us much time to shower. With the ending of our game so close to the start of the Walleye game, we ask that our players do not interact with members of the Walleye or KWings while in the tunnel/locker room areas.



HOTEL Hilton Garden Inn Toledo Downtown has been chosen as the host hotel for our Toledo scrimmage. The hotel is located 0.2 miles from the arena.
